

## West Wittering Primary School

### PE and Sport Funding initial plan 2013 - 2014

**Rationale:** The Government guidelines state that the purpose of the funding is to 'develop an enjoyment of sport and physical activity, promoting a healthy lifestyle in children from an early age.' The expectation is that the funding is spent on improving our provision of PE and sport, in ways which we consider appropriate to our specific needs.

As a small school we have always been aware of the need to offer as broad and rich a curriculum as possible, drawing upon staff talents and specialisms at any given point, and taking advantage of other initiatives or adult expertise which may become available to us. We have been successful in this aim, including in the realm of PE. School leaders and Governors take a proactive approach to staff changes, anticipating, as far as is possible, where adjustments, adaptation and innovation may be required; they seek a range of ways to secure good quality provision and this funding will be used to further support development.

Amount: £8,440 2013/14 (£8,000 + £5 per head Yr 1 to Yr 6), and likely to be the same again 2014/15. First tranche 2013/14 November 2013 £5,144. Second tranche 2013/14 April 2014 £3,296.

The impact of initial spending will be evaluated and will feed into a more detailed Year 2 plan which will be formulated during Summer Term 2014. Local offers, developing links with sports clubs, and staff expertise will also impact on the content of this long term development plan.

Detailed costings have been approved by Governors.
